Project description (Goals and expected outcomes)	Description: Prepares the Congo–Zambezi Water Transfer Project to move 16 billion m³/year from the Lualaba River to Lake Kariba via a 900km tunnel through DRC and Zambia, with off-river reservoirs near Victoria Falls, benefiting other SADC basins.
	Goals:Secure water for energy, domestic, industrial, agricultural, and mining use; boost Zambezi hydropower by 30%; protect Victoria Falls; and revive tourism in Kariba.
	Outcomes:Enhanced climate resilience, regional integration, food and water security, climate mitigation, jobs, and economic growth.
	Objectives: Deliver a full feasibility study—technical, financial, and environmental—covering design, PPP potential, ESIA, and RAP.
Technological details/ innovation	Gravity flow via an 18m, 900km tunnel through DRC and Zambia enables low-cost water transfer, eliminating pumping barriers and unlocking WEFE development.
